The property has been in the owner's family since 1905, when the grandfather bought 50 acres for firewood and Christmas trees. The property wasn't developed until 1990, when the owners fell in love with the view, the incredible sunsets and the privacy and decided to build their dream home. One being a contractor and the other being an interior designer, they saw the potential of blasting into the rock giving the opportunity to keep the living space on one level, making for an easy flow. Both owners were very involved with the design, creating an open plan with numerous windows and skylights allowing for natural light and the ability to take advantage of the incredible views. The kitchen is in the centre of the house, with views of the ocean and mountains and also to the back garden. The patio off the kitchen is a delightful place to sit and have your morning coffee. The master bedroom is at one end of the house separating it from the other bedrooms, with views to the ocean plus access to a lovely little patio/garden. The formal living room has large windows, with yet another opportunity to admire the view. The fireplaces in both the living room and family room are both very unique.
